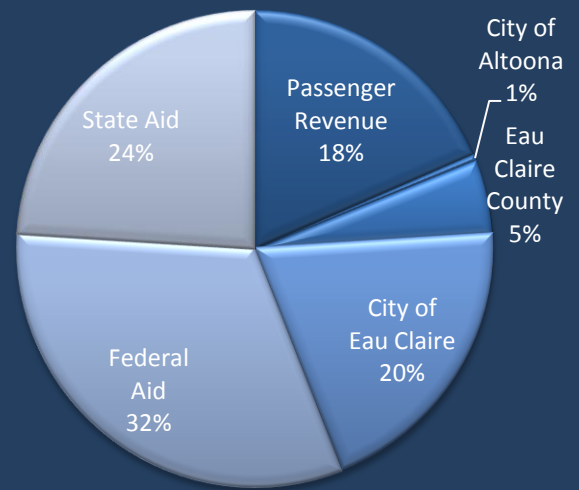

## 2016 Highlights

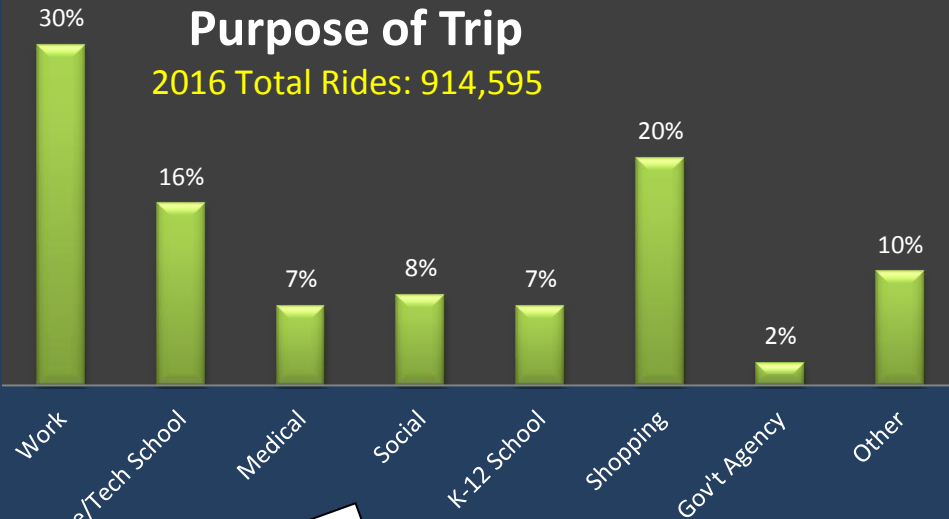
- In order to remove cash handling from the drivers, Eau Claire Transit partnered with local businesses to implement a voucher system.

*Eau Claire Transit currently has funding to replace 1 bus per year. We need to be replacing 2 per year to maintain a viable fleet.*
