Namekagon Transit was established in 1998 as a shuttle system for the Lac Courte Oreilles Casino. Today we still use the Lac Courte Oreilles Casino as a hub for our fixed route service, but have since expanded with Door Stop service to include all of Sawyer County as well as Barron and Washburn counties.
