Shared Ride Taxi

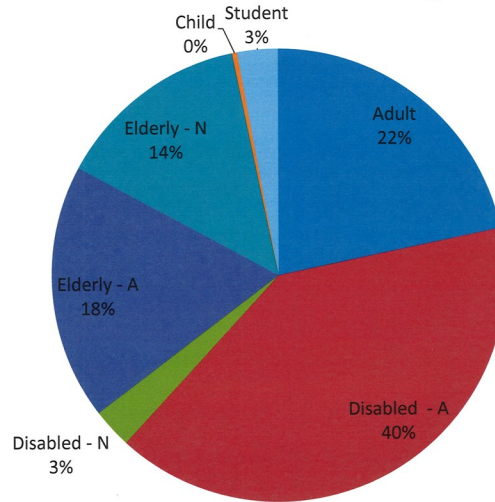
The citizens of Washington County will be provided a safe and efficient highway system throughout the county as well as a safe, clean, reliable, accessible, and cost effective public transit system as an alternative to the use of privately owned vehicles.

Washington County Transit contracts with a 3rd party private provider for the services of the Shared Ride Taxi. The Transit Manager is the only dedicated public transit employee that oversees the Shared Ride Taxi.

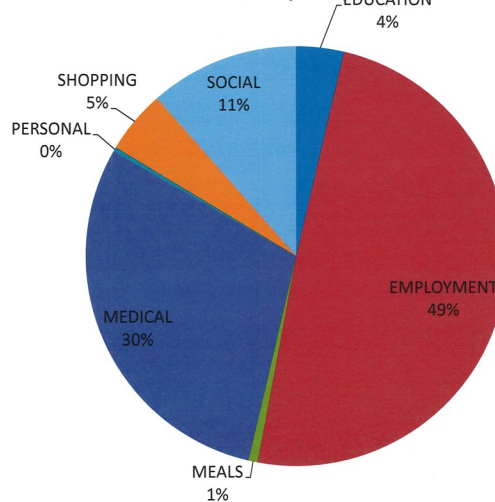
The Shared Ride Taxi started in 1998 and provided 22,428 rides that year. 91,620 rides were provided in 2016. The Shared Ride Taxi operates 27 vehicles; 7 days a week. The Shared Ride Taxi travels throughout all of Washington County and a small northern portion of Menomonee Falls in Waukesha County.

The service provides transportation to all client types. 75 percent of trips are for elderly and disabled riders. Specialized Service (door to door service) is provided for the elderly and disabled. The vehicles are wheelchair accessible by either lift or ramp.

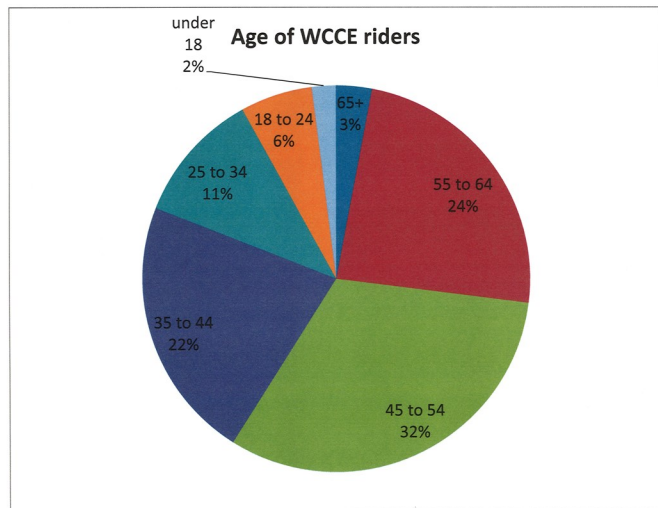
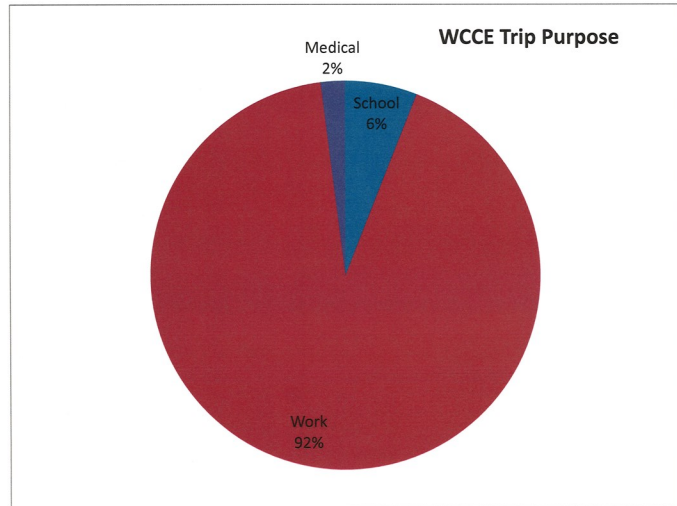

Commuter Express

The citizens of Washington County will be provided a safe and efficient highway system throughout the county as well as a safe, clean, reliable, accessible, and cost effective public transit system as an alternative to the use of privately owned vehicles.

Washington County Transit contracts with a 3rd party private provider for the services of the Washington County Commuter Express (WCCE). The Transit Manager is the only dedicated public transit employee that oversees the Commuter Express.

The WCCE started in 2000 and provided 8,347 rides that year. In 2016, WCCE provided 91,901 rides. The WCCE operates 8 motor-coaches with 11 morning runs and 11 afternoon runs. The WCCE provides weekday service to first shift commuters from 3 park & ride lots in Washington County to the Milwaukee Regional Medical Center, Clement Zablocki VA Medical Center, various stops along Wisconsin Avenue in downtown Milwaukee, Marquette University, Marquette University High School, and Schlitz Business Park. The motor-coach buses are equipped with wheelchair lift, WIFI, and restroom.
