

Waukesha Metro Transit Facts



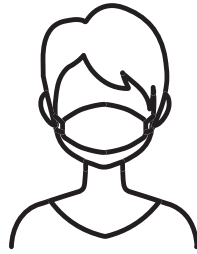
The City of Waukesha Metro buses operate seven days a week, with:

Metro's goal is to provide quality cost-efficient transportation to the Waukesha Community.

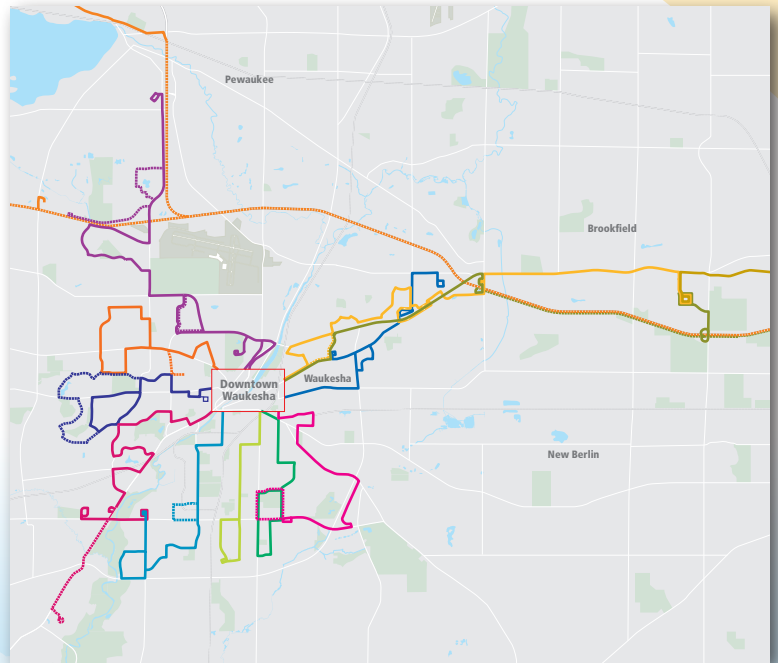
COVID Response

Waukesha County Transit Facts



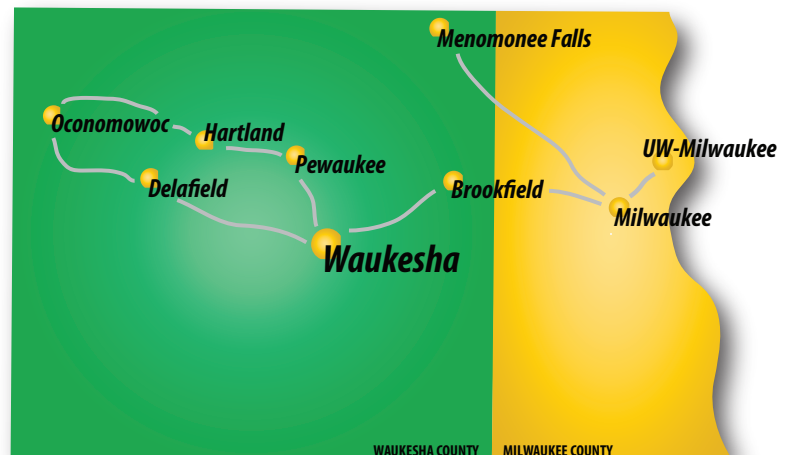
Waukesha County Transit consists of 6 routes:
